This new **6 Week Job Club** provides a network for social and technical support for young adults on the Autism Spectrum. The curriculum will be developed and tailored to best meet the needs of attending members.

Potential weekly modules will include skill development in a variety of employment related topics and activities including: *setting employment goals, understanding the world of work, creating resumes, development of employment soft skills for success, practicing interview skills, understanding/starting the job hunting process, etc.* All members will have the opportunity to develop a portfolio of work related materials (interest inventory, work goal sheet, resume/strengths and skills profile, and mock interview practice and feedback).

Information and activities will be delivered through small group activities and mentoring provided by University of Scranton Clinical Rehabilitation Counseling graduate students and faculty.
